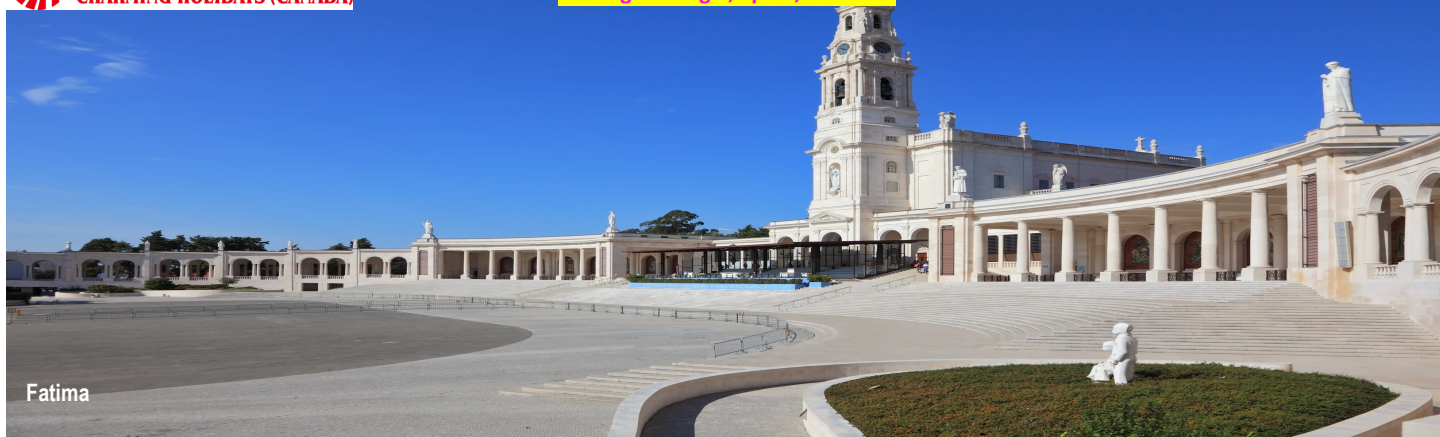

Day 3 Obidos ~ Fatima ~ Cabo Da Roca ~ Cascais

Day 5 Seville ~ Gibraltar (inside visit) ~ Mijas ~ Costa Del Sol

Day 6 Costa Del Sol ~ Granada (Alhambra Palace Gardens) ~ Cordoba (The Great Mosque)

Leave Costa Del Sol for Granada. Upon arrival, we will tour the Alhambra Palace Gardens to admire its exquisite beauty. Then, onto Cordoba. The inside visit to The Great Mosque will be the highlight in the afternoon. Our professional guide will explain to you how the Mosque was built in 785AD and later converted to a Cathedral in 1236. The Mosque uniquely displays a forest of columns and arches. Afterwards, a brief orientation on this ancient city is arranged. (Remarks: The Granada Cathedral will be replaced, should the admission to the Alhambra Palace Gardens be not available)

Day 7 Cordoba ~ Consuegra ~ Toledo ~ Madrid (Colon Square)

Coach to Toledo with a photo stop at Consuegra, famous for its Seven Windmills in a local fiction. Upon arrival, we will be escorted by a professional guide to the inside of the Grand Cathedral with richly decorated columns and beautiful stained-glass windows. The Choir, the altar of the Choir, Capilla Mayor and Santiago and two exceptional paintings are all considered one of the most treasurable and rare art collections in the ancient times. Continue to Madrid, the capital of Spain, for overnight stay.

Day 8 Royal Palace ~ Segovia (city tour) ~ Puerta Del Sol

An inside guided tour to the Royal Palace for its lovely chambers, banquet halls, paintings and sculptures is a must in the morning. Then, onto Segovia, an ancient capital where the Roman aqueducts are well preserved. Typical local lunch with roasted pig in old Portuguese tradition and a tour to the "Hero" Castle are provided. Return to Madrid for shopping in the late afternoon.

Day 9 Madrid ~ Zaragoza ~ Barcelona

Coach to Zaragoza. Tour the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Pillar built in the 16th century and designed in Islamic and Gothic style. The famous ceiling painting was done by Francisco Goya. Drive to Barcelona, the second largest city in Spain, for overnight stay.

Day 10 Barcelona (city tour) ~ Sagrada Familia Cathedral ~ Gaudi Guell Park ~ Ramblas optional tour Montserrat (Black Madonna)

The morning tour will include an impressive Cathedral, the Gaudi's Sagrada Familia and many of its eccentric architectural masterpieces, the famous Guell Park, 1992 Olympic Stadium, etc. Later, drive to the top of Mt Park for a panoramic view of the city. Return to downtown Barcelona where you can stroll around the lively Ramblas area with its open-air markets or join an optional tour to Montserrat (Black Madonna). (Remarks: Casa Mila will be replaced, should the admission to the Sagrada Familia Cathedral be not available)
