Day 1 Home City ✈ Bucharest

Depart from home city for Bucharest, the capital of Romania.

Day 2 Bucharest

Arrive at Bucharest. You will be greeted and transferred to the hotel for rest and overnight.

Day 3 The Bran Castle ~ Peles Castle

The first visit in the full day tour is the Bran Castle known as the vampire Dracula Castle and by the "Twilight" movie series. Then, onto Peles Castle, a neo-Renaissance palace in the Royal Domain of Sinaia, inaugurated in 1883 and built for King Carol I of Romania. All the chambers inside varied by function or by style, are lavishly furnished and decorated to the slightest detail.

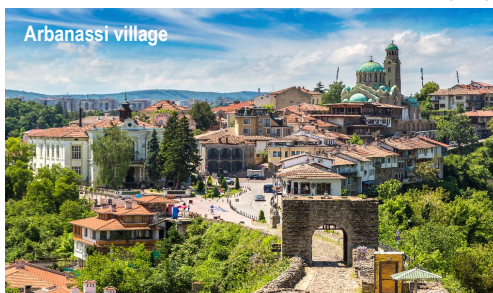

Day 4 Bucharest (city tour) ~ Veliko Tarnovo

The morning city tour includes the Houses of People, Old Town, Revolution Square, Arc of Triumph, etc. Later, leave Bucharest for Veliko Tarnovo, once the old capital of Bulgaria. Enroute, we will tour the Arbanassi medieval village for its monuments and churches. Finally, photo stops at the Tsarevets and the streets of artists are arranged upon arrival. In the evening, we will savour typical Bulgarian cuisine with lamb and Shopska salad.

Day 5 Veliko Tarnovo ~ Sofia (city tour)

Head south for Sofia, the capital of Bulgaria where a city tour will be provided on arrival. Our first stop will be the famous Alexander Nevsky Cathedral, the largest church in the Balkans and as well, the largest finished Orthodox cathedral until the year 2000. It can hold 5,000 people inside. Other sightseeing spots will include the Opera House, Memorial monument, city center, etc. In the evening, the dinner will be highlighted by folklore dance and drinks.

Day 6 Sofia ~ Skopje (city tour)

Before arriving at Skopje, the capital of Macedonia, a tour to Rila Monastery which is a UNESCO site, the largest Eastern Orthodox monastery in Bulgaria and located at an altitude of 1147 meters above sea level, is arranged. One of the most precious items inside is the gold-plated iconostasis for its wood-carving. An immediate sightseeing on arrival at Skopje will cover the Stone Bridge, old Bazaar, Mother Teresa Church, etc.

Day 7 Skopje ~ Ohrid (optional Ohrid Lake Boat tour) ~ Tirana (city tour)

At Ohrid, we will make stops at St Panteleimon Church famous for its wall painting and St Sophia Church known as the most important monuments of North Macedonia, housing architecture and art from the Middle Ages. An optional cruise ride to enjoy Ohrid Lake is available. Continue to Tirana, the capital of Albania, for a city tour where Et'Hem Bey Mosque, Clock Tower, Skanderbeg Square, the old Plaza, etc are all in the sightseeing list.

Day 8 Tirana ~ Skadar National Park ~ Budva (city tour)

Highlights in the morning will be the Skadar National Park and a boat ride in Lake Shkodra, the largest in the Balkan Peninsula. Lunch with a special fish menu is served. In the afternoon, we will arrive at Budva, a Montenegro city over 2,000 years old. The first stop at Sveti Stefan Island, a UNESCO Heritage site for photo taking, is a must before starting the city tour to churches, towers and narrow streets filled with souvenir shops.

Day 9 Budva ~ Kotor (city tour / optional Our Lady of the Rocks tour) ~ Dubrovnik

Coach to Kotor, a well preserved medieval town in the southern part of Montenegro and also a UNESCO Heritage Site. A walking tour will show you all the places of interest that the city can offer or join an optional tour to Our Lady of the Rocks by boat. Later, onto Dubrovnik, Croatia, the pearl of the Adriatic for overnight stay.

Day 10 Dubrovnik (city tour / optional Mali Ston tour) ~ Mostar

A walking tour in this morning will start from St Franciscan Monastery for its church, the Rector Palace, a pharmacy, the oldest in Europe. Onto the downtown Placa Square where souvenir and coffee shops are everywhere. Lastly, a pleasant walk along the 12th-century walls to learn of their history and enjoy the panoramic rooftop and Adriatic view. An optional tour to visit Mali Ston, famous for its fresh oysters is available. Continue to Mostar, a small Bosnia medieval town on the bank of River Neretva for overnight stay.

Day 11 Mostar ~ Sarajevo (city tour)

We will tour the iconic Stari Most (The Old Bridge), a reconstructed medieval arched bridge built in the 16th century by the Ottomans and many other landmarks of Bosnia - Herzegovina with charming stone streets. Continue by coach to Sarajevo, the capital of Bosnia. Immediately upon arrival at Sarajevo, the city tour will cover the tunnel museum built in 1993 during the Siege of Sarajevo in the midst of the Bosnia War, Ali Pasha Mosque, built as the legacy of Ali Pasha, an Ottoman governor, the 500 years old town and the Bascarsija, the old Arabian style market, etc. In the evening, a traditional Bosnia dinner with cevapci is served.

Day 12 Sarajevo ~ Belgrade

After crossing the Drina river by the border, a full-day drive will take you from Sarajevo to Belgrade, the capital of Serbia, for overnight stay.

Day 13 Belgrade (city tour) ~ at leisure / optional Belgrade boat tour

The morning tour will start with the Kalemegdan Fortress, the most visited tourist attraction in Belgrade, which was declared a Monument of Culture of Exceptional Importance. Then, onto St. Sava Cathedral. It is the largest Orthodox Church, contains the biggest mosaic in the world and represents the cooperative spirit of the peoples of Serbia and Russia who worked together to finalize the interior decorations. The Knez Mihailova street, the main pedestrian and shopping zone, and Skadarlija area, a vintage street, are not to be missed out. In the afternoon, you will be free to explore the city on your own or join an optional boat tour to enjoy a river cruise through the beautiful city of Belgrade.
