Day 1 Home City Paris

Depart from home city for Paris, the capital of France.

Day 2 Paris (Louvre Museum) ~ Shopping / optional River Seine cruise

Arrive at Paris. The first stop is at Louvre Museum where the immortal painting of Mona Lisa, Winged Victory of Samothrace, Venus de Milo, the Great Sphinx of Tanis, etc. are housed. Afterwards, a shopping stop for around 2 hours at Lafayette or Printemps Department store is provided. Lastly, an optional cruise along the River Seine is highly recommended as another way to discover Paris.

Day 3 Paris (city tour) ~ Montmartre Hill ~ at leisure / optional Verailles Palace tour

The morning tour will pass the Champs Elysees, Arc de Triomphe, Tomb of Invalides, Eiffel Tower, Concorde Square. The final stop is at the Montmartre Hill which is the gathering place for local artists. The remaining part of the day is free for you to explore the city on your own or join an optional tour to Versailles Palace. In the evening, another
