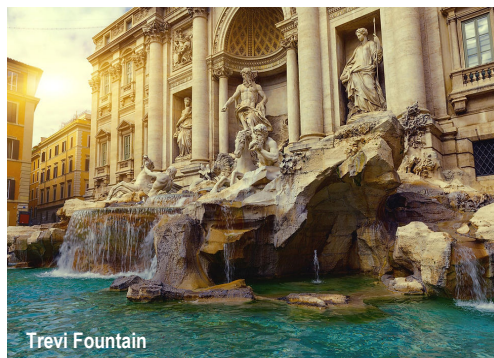
Day 1 Home City ✈ Rome

Depart from home city for Rome, the capital of Italy.

Day 2 Rome (city tour) ~ Vatican City

Arrive at Rome, a city with a unique blend of history, culture and world famous monuments. The afternoon tour includes visits to the Trevi Fountain, a panoramic view of the Colosseum, the Roma Forum and an inside tour in the St. Peter's Basilica, etc.

Day 3 Rome ~ Pisa ~ Florence (city tour)

Coach to Pisa for photo taking of the famous Leaning Tower. Then onto Florence, the cradle of Renaissance. Stop at Piazzale Michelangelo for a panoramic view of the city. The multi-colored marble Cathedral, Signoria Square, etc. are all included in the sightseeing tour.

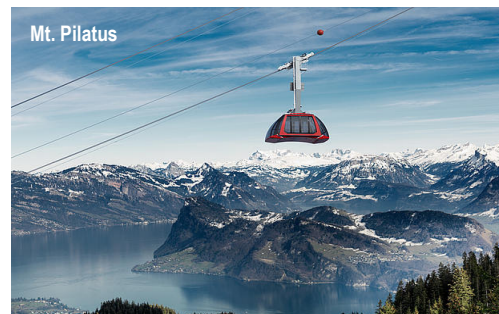

Day 6 Lucerne (city tour) ~ at leisure / optional Mt. Pilatus excursion ~ Beaune

After the visits to the Lion Monument and the Chapel Bridge in the morning, you may explore the city on your own. An optional excursion to Mt. Pilatus is available, where you will enjoy the stunning scenery of Alpine snow capped mountains. Afterwards, leave Lucerne for Beaune. Dinner will be served with escargots and pork chop in mustard sauce.

Day 7 Beaune ~ Paris (Louvre Museum) ~ Shopping / optional River Seine cruise

Coach to Paris. Upon arrival, the first stop is at Louvre Museum where the immortal painting of Mona Lisa, Winged Victory of Samothrace, Venus de Milo, the Great Sphinx of Tanis, etc are housed. Afterwards, a shopping stop for around 2 hours at Lafayette or Printemps Department stores is provided. Lastly, an optional cruise along the River Seine is highly recommended as another way to discover Paris.

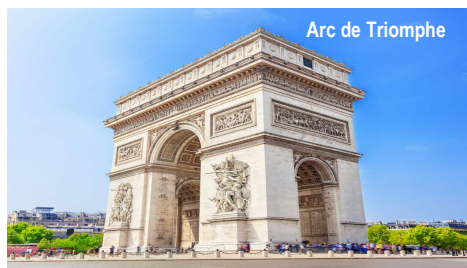
Day 8 Paris (city tour) ~ Montmartre Hill ~ at leisure / optional Versailles Palace tour

Day 9 Paris ~ Eurostar train ~ London (British Museum)
