Day 3 Vienna (city tour) ~ / optional Schönbrunn Palace (inside visit) ~ Budapest

Or our escort can arrange a pay option for inside visit of the magnificent Schönbrunn Palace. Time is provided for the tour members to shop for Swarovski crystals before proceeding to Budapest, the capital of Hungary. The dinner is served with traditional Hungarian goulash cuisine and folk dance.

Day 4 Budapest (city tour) ~ optional tour Danube River cruise ~ Zagreb

Day 6 Zagreb (city tour) ~ Ljubljana (city tour)

Day 9 Prague (city tour) ~ / optional tour VItava River Cruise) ~ at leisure

The first visit in the morning will be to the Hradcany Castle, formerly the King's home, now the residence of the President. Later, pass the St Vitus Cathedral to arrive at the center of the old town. The Clock Tower, The Clock Square and the renowned Charles Bridges are not to be missed out. Afternoon will be free for you to explore the city on your own or join an optional Vltava River cruise along beautiful Prague's Old Town. Typical dinner with mixed meats and dark beer will be served in a local restaurant.

Day 10 Prague ~ Dresden (city tour) ~ Berlin

Coach to Dresden where a city tour will include the Zwinger Palace, Semper Opera, Saxon Wall, the 18th century Cathedral, etc. Lunch is highlighted by typical German Knuckle. Before arriving at Berlin, the capital of Germany, for overnight stay, we will visit Wilhelm memorial church which was severely devastated during World War II.

Day 11 Berlin (city tour) ~ Potsdam

Coach to Potsdam where the famous treaty among Russia, USA and UK was signed in the Second World War. Inside visits will be made at the Sanssouci Palace, a former summer residence of Frederick the Great known for its stunning Rococo architecture and beautiful terraced gardens. Later, return to the city to visit the Berlin Wall, Tiergarten, German State Opera House, Reichstag Building, Charlie Checkpoint, etc. Typical dinner with German beefsteak and beer will be served.
