

*The hotel check-in is available after 3pm with your passport. Guests arriving early at the hotel please store luggage by own and then can freely explore Tokyo city.



After breakfast, start your trip of Tokyo with our tour guide. Enjoy your time in Ginza, which is Tokyo's most famous upmarket shopping, dining and entertainment district. Tsukiji Outer Market is a foodie wonderland, especially for seafood lovers. Just find out what to see & where to eat at this Tokyo landmark by yourself. Visit Meiji Shrine, surrounded by a lush green forest right in the heart of Tokyo, this Shinto shrine is dedicated to Emperor Meiji and Empress Shoken, who led Japan to become a modernized nation. Have a stop at Shibuya, the birthplace to many of Japan's fashion and entertainment trends. Then take the Hokuriku Shinkansen to Kanazawa. Lunch and Dinner are on your own arrangement.

D4 Kanazawa

After breakfast, visit Kenroku-en Garden which is the top of the three famous gardens in Japan, and then visit Nagamachi Buke Yashiki District. Here is the site of the former residences of the samurai. The ancient streets are lined with well-preserved earthen walls and exquisite wooden buildings, exuding a rich historical charm. Visit Omicho Market, you can enjoy delicious food freely in this 300-year-old market. Then, enjoy your free time at Higashi Chaya District, where the beautiful street scenery exudes an elegant ancient Japanese style. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

D5 Kanazawa - Shirakawa-go - Takayama

After breakfast, head to visit the world cultural heritage - Shirakawa Village which has been isolated from the outside world for a long time. Appreciate the enchanting scenery where the gassho-zukuri villages are interwoven with the natural beauty. Stand on the Ogimachi Castle Site Observatory to overlook the beautiful scenery of the fairy tale village. In the afternoon, head to Takayama. Enjoy one of Japan's four top-tier beef specialties—Hida Beef cuisine for dinner. Afterwards, you will be returned to the hot spring hotel.

D6 Takayama - Nagoya

After breakfast, visit Miyagawa Morning Market and enjoy fresh fruits. Afterwards, visit the only administrative office remains from the shogunate period in Japan - the Takayama Jinya. Freely stroll around Sanmachi Historic District and appreciate traditional taverns and ancient houses with grid figure on doors, windows, and partitions. Visit the Takayama Matsuriyadai Kaikan. Its solemn, beautiful, and splendid design is an artistic creation that combines traditional Japanese formal beauty with exquisite art and craftsmanship. Later, proceed to Nagoya. Upon arrival, you'll be transferred to hotel.

D7 Nagoya - Kyoto

After breakfast, visit the Nagoya Castle, which was the heart of one of the most important castle towns in Japan. Then transfer to Kyoto. Visit the famous Kinkakuji Temple. Afterwards, head to Gion. It is a good place to experience the ancient charm and culture of Kyoto. The Yasaka Shrine is almost always buzzing with energy, with eager devotees flocking to receive blessings and pray for good fortune. Walk on Hanamikoji, the most stylish geisha district in Japan from the Edo period. The Kamo River is a primary river flowing through Kyoto City. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

D8 Kyoto - Osaka

After breakfast, visit Kyoto Imperial Palace, the Japanese imperial family's former residence. Then, go to Fushimi Inari Taisha Shrine. The seemingly endless path of vibrant orange torii gates leading up Mt. Inari makes for an impressive setting and is one of the most famous images of Japan. Afterward, head to Nara to visit Nara Park where full of very playful and friendly deer. And don't miss the beautiful view in Kasuga Taisha Shrine. Visit the Osaka Castle Park (tower/museum excluded), the landmark of the Osaka city. This evening, visit Shinsaibashi, the largest shopping district in Osaka and taste the local cuisine at Dotonbori Food Street. Dinner is on your own arrangement.
