D1 Home/ Tokyo

Take the flight to Tokyo.

D2 Arrive in Tokyo*NRT/HND

Pick-up service are served from 08:00am to 22:00pm in Narita and Haneda Airport, we will have a receptionist onsite to assist you to transfer to the hotel.

*The hotel check-in is available after 3pm with your passport. Guests arriving early at the hotel please store luggage by own and then can freely explore Tokyo city.

D3 Tokyo-Mt.Fuji

After breakfast, visit Senso-ji Temple, which is the oldest temple in Tokyo, and enjoy the vibrant stalls of Nakamise Dori. View the tallest standing tower in the world – Tokyo Skytree from afar. Then, visit the famous Nijubashi Bridge, which is outside of the Imperial Palace out gardens. Later, head for Shinjuku Kabukicho. Finally, transfer to Hot Spring Hotel near Mt. Fuji Area and enjoy Japanese-Style hot spring and dinner.

Special adding spots in Spring(Departure date 22nd Mar-12th Apr): Chidorigafuchi Park, Shinjuku Gyoen

Special adding spots in Autumn(Departure date 18th Oct-15th Nov): Yoyogi Park, Rikugien Garden

D4 Mt.Fuji-Nagoya

In the morning, visit Mt. Fuji 5th Station, located halfway up the mountain (If weather not permitting, go to Mt. Fuji World Heritage Center instead). Then, head to Oshino Hakkai. The traditional buildings, slowly spinning water wheels and amazing view of Mt. Fuji all transport you to another era. Then go to Bussharito Heiwa Park to appreciate the gardening featured with Japanese characteristics. Later, transfer to Nagoya and stroll on the famous Osu Shopping District. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

D5 Nagoya-Kyoto

After breakfast, visit the Nagoya Castle, which was the heart of one of the most important castle towns in Japan. Then transfer to Kyoto. Visit Kinkakuji Temple, which is decorated by gold foil so the entire building sparkles with golden light. Afterwards, head to Gion. It is a good place to experience the ancient charm and culture of Kyoto. The Yasaka Shrine is almost always buzzing with energy, with eager devotees flocking to receive blessings and pray for good fortune. Walk on Hanamachi Street, the most stylish geisha district in Japan from the Edo period. The Kamo River is a primary river flowing through Kyoto City. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

Special adding spots in Spring(Departure date 22nd Mar-12th Apr): Maruyama Park

Special adding spots in Autumn(Departure date 18th Oct-15th Nov): Arashiyama Area-Togetsukyo Bridge

D6 Kyoto-Osaka

After breakfast, visit Kyoto Imperial Palace, the Japanese imperial family's former residence. Then, go to Fushimi Inari Taisha Shrine. The seemingly endless path of vibrant orange torii gates leading up Mt. Inari makes for an impressive setting and is one of the most famous images of Japan. Afterward, head to Nara to visit Nara Park where full of very playful and friendly deer. And don't miss the beautiful view in Kasuga Taisha Shrine. Visit the Osaka Castle Park (tower/museum excluded), the landmark of the Osaka city. This evening, visit Shinsaibashi, the largest shopping district in Osaka and taste the local cuisine at Dotonbori Food Street. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

D7 Osaka-Kobe-Himeji Hiroshima

In the morning, transfer to Kobe. Kobe Harborland is a shopping and entertainment district between JR Kobe Station and the waterfront of Kobe's port area. Visit Chinatown, a popular tourist attraction and shopping and dining district. Then transfer to visit Himeji Castle, also known as White Heron Castle due to its elegant, white appearance, is widely considered as Japan's most spectacular castle. At dusk, take the Shinkansen to Hiroshima (guide will accompany you). Lunch and dinner are on your own arrangement.

*Tips: Today you can store your large luggage at Osaka hotel and only need to bring one day's worth of carry-on bag.

D8 Hiroshima Osaka

After breakfast, transfer to visit Hiroshima Peace Memorial Park and Atomic Bomb Dome, commemorating one of the darkest moments in Japanese history, with the goal of promoting peace in the hope that history not is repeated. Then, take boat to Miyajima, it is one of the top three scenic spots in Japan. Visit Itsukushima Shinto Shrine, the Floating Shrine on the Sea has more than 1400 years of history, fits well with blue sea and green forest, recreating the elegance of the Heian era. Then take the Shinkansen back to Osaka. Lunch and dinner are on your own arrangement.

After breakfast, transfer to Kansai International Airport by public transportation on own expense (guide will give advice in advance). End of the journey.
