D3 Tokyo-Mt. Fuji

B, L, D

After breakfast, visit Senso-ji Temple, which is the oldest temple in Tokyo, and enjoy the vibrant stalls of Nakamise Dori. View the tallest standing tower in the world – Tokyo Skytree from afar. Then, visit the famous Nijubashi Bridge, which is outside of the Imperial Palace out gardens. Later, head for Shinjuku Kabukicho. Finally, transfer to Hot Spring Hotel near Mt. Fuji Area and enjoy Japanese-Style hot spring and dinner.

D4 Mt. Fuji-Nagoya

In the morning, visit Mt. Fuji 5th Station, located halfway up the mountain (If weather not permitting, go to Mt. Fuji World Heritage Center instead). Then, head to Oshino Hakkai. The traditional buildings, slowly spinning water wheels and amazing view of Mt. Fuji all transport you to another era. Then go to Bussharito Heiwa Park to appreciate the gardening featured with Japanese characteristics. Later, transfer to Nagoya and stroll on the famous Osu Shopping District. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

Hotel Keihan Nagoya or Hilton Nagoya or similar

D5 Nagoya-Kyoto

B, L

After breakfast, visit the Nagoya Castle, which was the heart of one of the most important castle towns in Japan. Then transfer to Kyoto. Visit Kinkakuji Temple, which is decorated by gold foil so the entire building sparkles with golden light. Afterwards, head to Gion. It is a good place to experience the ancient charm and culture of Kyoto. The Yasaka Shrine is almost always buzzing with energy, with eager devotees flocking to receive blessings and pray for good fortune. Walk on Hanamachi Street, the most stylish geisha district in Japan from the Edo period. The Kamo River is a primary river flowing through Kyoto City. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

D6 Kyoto-Osaka

After breakfast, visit Kyoto Imperial Palace, the Japanese imperial family's former residence. Then, go to Fushimi Inari Taisha Shrine. The seemingly endless path of vibrant orange torii gates leading up Mt. Inari makes for an impressive setting and is one of the most famous images of Japan. Afterward, head to Nara to visit Nara Park where full of very playful and friendly deer. And don't miss the beautiful view in Kasuga Taisha Shrine. Visit the Osaka Castle Park (tower/museum excluded), the landmark of the Osaka city. This evening, visit Shinsaibashi, the largest shopping district in Osaka and taste the local cuisine at Dotonbori Food Street. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

Osaka Sheraton Miyako or Hommachi Miyako or similar

D7 Osaka\*KIX/Sapporo\*CTS-Noboribetsu

After breakfast, take shuttle bus to airport(ticket included and guide will assist the day before) and fly to Hokkaido. Upon arrival at Sapporo (New Chitose) Airport, transfer to the hotel in Noboribetsu with our receptionist's assistance and enjoy delicious local cuisines in Hotel. (The dinner in hotel ends at 8 pm, if your flight arrive at late time and cannot catch up the dinner, it will be regarded as voluntary renounce with no refund.) Guests can check-in hotel after 3pm.

Park Hotel Miyabitei or similar

D8 Noboribetsu- Lake Toya-Hakodate

B, L, D

After breakfast, transfer to Noboribetsu Hell Valley, a crater and a main source of Noboribetsu's hot spring waters. Enjoy and experience the River Oyunuma Natural Footbath (\*Please bring your own towels). Then, visit Noboribetsu Date Jidaimura, a history-themed park that transports visitors back to the Edo period. Learn how ninjas and samurais lived too as you pass by authentic houses. Then, overlooking the ocean at Cape Chikyu, one of Hokkaido's most beautiful landscapes. Afterwards, visit the Lake Toya with spectacular scenery. Enjoy the million-dollar night view of Mt. Hakodate which ranks among the world's top three night views.

Hakodate Kokusai Hotel or similar

D9 Hakodate -Otaru

B, L, D

After breakfast, head to the highly popular Hakodate Morning Market among tourists. The Kanemori Red Brick Warehouse is one of Hakodate's most iconic attractions which exudes an exotic charm. Walk on Motomachi, admiring the historic architecture and immersing in the exotic atmosphere.Visit Onuma Quasi-National Park, home to abundant wildlife and lush green forests. Late Apr~Early May: change to Goryokaku Park to admire the dreamy and grand cherry blossoms in spring. Mid & Late May: change to Shiba Sakura Garden of Mr. Mishima to witness the spectacular carpet of vibrant flowers. Late Oct~Mid Nov : change to Kosetsuen to marvel at the breathtaking red leaves.

Grand Park Otaru or similar

D10 Otaru –Sapporo

B, L

After breakfast, walk along the old romantic Otaru Canal. The Otaru Music Box Museum is a popular sightseeing attraction and the largest music box museum in Otaru. Afterwards, go back to Sapporo, visit Sapporo Beer Museum. This is Japan's only museum dedicated to beer, which explores the long history of Sapporo Beer. Visit the Shiroi Koibito Park. It is a sweets theme park. Late May~Early Jun: change to Tenjin Wisteria, view the "Tenjin wisteria," Hokkaido's oldest one with a history of over 200 years. Mid Oct~Mid Nov: change to Mt. Moiwa Ropeway to admire the beautiful red maples at the top of the mountain. Enjoy yourself in the wonderful Tanuki Koji Street. Dinner is on your own arrangement.

Tokyu Rei Sapporo or similar

D11 Sapporo -Tokachigawa

B, L, D

After breakfast, visit the Former Hokkaido Government Office which is Hokkaido's best-known symbol and the red star on its exterior wall is the symbol of the Hokkaido Development Commission. Have a photo stop at the pink station house of Kofuku Station with the walls becoming covered in the cards of visitors hoping for good luck. Then, head to Ikeda Wine Castle which is famous for its unique medieval European-style castle exterior and its role in revitalizing the local economy. It is Japan's first winery operated by local government. Late Jan~Mid Mar: change to Lake Shikaribetsuko Kotan, where you can witness the unique cultural phenomenon of igloos. Jan~Mar & Nov~Dec: change to Tsurumidai, offering the best opportunity to admire the charm of red-crowned cranes.
